

Safety Precautions in effect during Pandemic

The Mossman Play Therapy Center is taking the following precautions to protect our clients and staff, and to help slow the spread of the Coronavirus:

- Our waiting room is closed during this time.
- All staff and clients are required to wear a mask at all times.
- Disposable masks will be provided to clients who need them.
- Our staff maintains safe distancing whenever possible.
- Restroom soap dispensers are maintained and everyone is required to wash their hands prior to entering the office. If, for some reason, the bathrooms do not have soap available, our staff has soap that can be provided to you.
- Hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol is available in the waiting room and in all playrooms.
- We schedule appointments at specific intervals to minimize the number of people crossing paths when arriving and leaving appointments.
- We ask all families to wait in their cars or outside until their appointment times. Only the child with the appointment and one caregiver are asked to enter into the building.
- All clients will be given their own individualized art boxes. These boxes will contain crayons, markers, scissors, paint brushes, paint palettes, and additional individualized art/play supplies. Children will be given their supplies at the beginning of each session and the supplies will be secured and stored for them until their next appointment. These kits will not be shared with any other clients.
- The closet area in the playroom will be closed. If there are items in the closet that your child or clinician want to use during session, your clinician will enter the closet and obtain the item for the session. This item will then be sanitized prior to any other child using the item.
- Certain, harder to clean items have been removed from the playroom.
- The playroom will be wiped down between sessions.
- An air purifier has been placed in the playroom. Though air purifiers do not eliminate the risk
 of becoming infected by a virus, the purifier will increase air flow in the room and filter some
 of the air.
- Tissues and trash bins are easily accessed. Trash is disposed of on a frequent basis.
- Common areas are wiped down throughout the day and thoroughly disinfected at the end of each day.
